ACT OF REMEMBRANCE - SUNDAY 8thth NOVEMBER, 2020

Brangore's official Remembrance Sunday service for the Parish residents to pay their respects to people killed in conflict has been cancelled this year due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

The decision follows advice from Government and New Forest District Council and other local Groups.

It is extremely disappointing that we find ourselves in this position, however, we must think of the safety of the public during this time and adhere to Government guidance.

The laying of wreaths at the War Memorial on Sunday, 8th November, 2020 will be permitted on a personal basis but all social distancing requirements will be the responsibility of those who wish to lay wreaths on that day.
